AQ FUNDING FOR COACHING EQUIPMENT

Clubs affiliated with AQ in both SQAS (including northern NSW clubs) and NQAA, and the RGBs SQAS and NQAA shall be able to receive funds from AQ to help purchase electronic coaching equipment for coaches for archers on a development pathway. Funds are limited and will be allocated on an assessed basis.

Closing Date

A notice by email of the intent to access the scheme must be sent to the President president@archeryqueensland.org.au by **31 October 2020**. No funds may be spent before an acknowledgement is received.

Eligibility

Club/RGB affiliated with Archery Queensland, and operating under SQAS and NQAA.

Club must demonstrate an active coaching program

Must have qualified coaches L2 or L3 and/or qualified archery instructors L1 who are active in coaching archers on a development pathway (this equipment support is not for beginners courses)

Must warrant that the grant will be used only for coaching purposes at the club or RGB level.

What can be applied for

For **50%** of the cost of electronic coaching equipment up to a maximum of **\$500** per club or RGB.

Examples of coaching equipment being targeted by this initiative are ...

- Tablet, memory, and tripod for video coaching and recording
- Coaching software such as Coaches Eye

AQ is seeking to create a list of equipment ideas and recommendations would be appreciated.

Notice of Intent to Access the Scheme - Application

The application should describe

- the organisation applying
- the clubs/RGBs active coaching program
- what is proposed to be purchased
- the contribution requested up to **50%** of the total up to a maximum of **\$500**
- what programs it will be used for, the level of use proposed and who will use the equipment
- agreement to the use of the equipment for the intended purpose

Preference will be given to electronic coaching equipment for use ...

- By Coaches L2 or L3, or
- For para and VI coaching support

Payment

Payment will be made to those clubs/RGBs awarded funding, on the submission of receipts. Receipts must be submitted by to the Treasurer by **31 January 2021** to be claimable.
