1.1	<p>School / Community Group Archery Program a Beginners Course which is -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • delivered to a specific educational institution (including home schooling and other Youth groups - eg Scouts) over a single school Term or equivalent timeframe; and • it is expected that participants would be of Primary or High School age (generally 18 years or younger) - class teachers may also be included within the program for the purposes of funding; and • delivered by Archery Australia certified Archery Instructors in accordance with the Archery Australia Beginners Course; and • delivered at the school grounds, club grounds or similar facility that allows for appropriate safety requirements.
1.2	<p>Come 'n Try A 'Come 'n Try' is -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a 3 hour (min) program delivered on 1 day designed for a specific Youth group to try archery (eg scouts, guides etc); and • delivered by Archery Australia certified Archery Instructors in accordance with the Archery Australia Come 'n Try; and • delivered at school grounds, club grounds or similar facility that allows for appropriate safety requirements.
1.3	<p>Archery Awareness The aims of this program are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • introduce target archery to an area / town that does not currently have a target archery presence. • assist in the development of a local club.
1.4	<p>Talent Identification & Participation Pathways <u>QUEENSLAND CHAMPIONSHIPS</u> - Conducted over 2 days at multiple venues (Brisbane, Townsville and Mareeba). Objective is to identify new and existing talented archers who could benefit from additional mentoring or coaching. Including possible invitations to attend Youth Camps. <u>YOUTH CAMPS</u> - Camps to provide intensive training to talented young archers prior to National and International events.</p>
2.1	<p>Coaching Accreditation Courses designed and run by accredited World Archery / Archery Australia persons for the accreditation of new Archery Instructors or Club Coaches. Courses designed and run by accredited World Archery / Archery Australia persons for the maintenance and / or enhancement of Archery Instructor or Club Coach skills.</p>
2.2	<p>National Judge Accreditation Courses designed and run by accredited World Archery / Archery Australia persons for the accreditation of new National Judge Candidates. Courses designed and run by accredited World Archery / Archery Australia persons for the maintenance and / or enhancement of National Judge or National Judge Candidate skills.</p>
2.3	<p>Risk Management / Compliance Workshops Workshops designed specifically to enhance skills of archery officials for Risk Management / Compliance programs.</p>
3.1	<p>Communication Programs / activities designed to enhance communication within, for or to the archery clubs or individual archers. Programs / activities designed to increase archery awareness within the community.</p>
